DPDP compliance. This Platform, and this Agreement, are designed and maintained in compliance with India's Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023 ("DPDP Act") — see Part B (Privacy Policy) for full detail.

How this document is used. This is Medius Earth's standard Platform Access Agreement — the same technology license, privacy policy, and terms of use are issued to every client and Authorized User. Each engagement additionally has its own Scope Document and commercial/pricing terms, which are agreed and signed separately (see Section A.2.4). This Agreement may be signed electronically through the Platform's onboarding flow, or executed separately as a standalone signed document — see "Acceptance of Agreement" at the end of this document.

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Executive Summary — Read This First

This summary explains, in simple language, what you are agreeing to when you accept the Platform Access Agreement. It is not a substitute for the full document that follows — the legal wording in Parts A, B and C is what actually governs your access and use of the Medius Earth platform. If anything here and the detailed text disagree, the detailed text controls.

1. What is this document?

When Medius Earth gives you — or your organization — access to its technology platform (the dMRV and carbon project management system, including its dashboards, mobile/WhatsApp data capture tools, AI-assisted analysis, and data room), you are asked to accept three things bundled into one agreement:

- **A License Agreement** — the rules for using Medius Earth's software and technology.
- **A Privacy Policy** — how we collect, use, protect, and share personal and project data, in line with India's DPDP Act, 2023.
- **Terms and Conditions of Use** — the day-to-day rules of conduct on the platform, and what happens if something goes wrong.

This applies whether you are a Medius Earth employee, a field team member, a supervisor, a partner project developer, a ground operator, a funder, an auditor/VVB, a carbon registry, or any other external party we grant access to.

This Agreement is separate from your project's Scope Document and commercials. This Agreement covers platform access, licensing, IP and data terms only. The specific project scope, deliverables, timelines, and pricing for your organization's engagement are set out in a separate Scope Document and/or commercial agreement, signed independently — see Section A.2.4 for how the two relate.

2. What you get (the License, in brief)

- A limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable right to log in and use the platform for the purpose your access was granted for — e.g., field data capture, project monitoring, verification review, or investment due diligence.
- You do not own the platform, its underlying software, or its AI models. Medius Earth (Hasten Forestry India Pvt. Ltd.) retains all ownership and intellectual property rights.
- You may not copy, reverse-engineer, resell, sub-license, or build a competing product using the platform or the data structures behind it.
- Access can be role-based and limited — different users (field staff, corporate office, funders, auditors, registries) may see different parts of the platform.
- Access is granted only for as long as your engagement, contract, or employment with or through Medius Earth continues, and can be suspended or revoked as described in Part A.

- If your organization also has a Scope Document, commercial agreement, or a separate organization-level agreement with Medius Earth, that agreement governs the business terms of your engagement (fees, deliverables, timelines); this Agreement governs the technology, IP, and data terms.

3. What happens to your data (the Privacy Policy, in brief)

- We collect account details, field data (photos, GPS locations, voice recordings in local languages, survey responses), usage logs, and — where applicable — financial and project documentation.
- We use this data to run the platform, generate reports, verify carbon claims, and share audit-ready information with the parties who legitimately need it — such as registries (e.g., Verra), verification bodies (VVBs), funders, and project developers you work with.
- All data is encrypted, access-controlled, and logged — every action on the platform is auditable.
- **Data ownership stays with you.** You (or your organization) own the data you put into the Platform. Medius Earth is licensed to use it to run and improve your project, and may separately use it in anonymized, aggregated form — where you, your project, and your site cannot reasonably be identified — to improve its AI models and the Platform generally.
- We do not sell your personal data. We share it only with the specific parties necessary to run and verify your project, or as required by law.
- You have rights over your own personal data — you can ask to see it, correct it, or request its deletion, subject to the legal and contractual reasons we may need to keep certain records (e.g., audit trails for carbon verification).
- This Policy is designed to comply with India's Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023 (DPDP Act).

4. Rules of the road (Terms and Conditions, in brief)

- Use the platform honestly and accurately — the integrity of carbon and ESG data depends on what you enter being true and current.
- AI-generated outputs (analysis, summaries, translations, reports) are decision-support tools, not final determinations — a human should review anything used for verification, financing, or regulatory submission.
- Don't misuse the platform: no unauthorized access, no interfering with security, no uploading unlawful or harmful content, no sharing your login.
- Medius Earth can suspend or terminate access for breach of these terms, non-payment (where fees apply), or if required for legal or security reasons.
- The platform is provided "as is" — we work hard to keep it accurate and available, but we do not guarantee it will be error-free or uninterrupted, and liability for losses is limited as described in Part C.
- Disputes are governed by Indian law and resolved through the process described in Part A/C (negotiation, then arbitration in Bengaluru).

5. What clicking "I Accept" means

By accepting this agreement — electronically through the Platform's onboarding flow, or by physical or digital signature outside the Platform — you confirm that you have authority to accept on behalf of yourself or your

organization, that you have read (or had the opportunity to read) the full document, and that you agree to be bound by the License Agreement (Part A), Privacy Policy (Part B), and Terms and Conditions of Use (Part C) that follow. Either method of acceptance is equally valid and binding; see "Acceptance of Agreement" at the end of this document.

IN PLAIN ENGLISH

In short: you get to use a powerful, secure platform to manage and prove your restoration/carbon project. In exchange, you agree to use it responsibly, keep your data honest, and respect that the technology itself belongs to Medius Earth. Your data stays yours — we use it to run and improve your project, and we may learn from it (anonymously) to improve the Platform for everyone. Your scope of work and commercial terms live in a separate document; this one covers the technology, IP, and data rules that apply the same way to every client.

Part A — Technology Platform License Agreement

This License Agreement ("License") is entered into between Hasten Forestry India Private Limited, operating as Medius Earth ("Medius Earth", "we", "us", "our"), and the individual or entity accepting these terms ("User", "Licensee", "you"), governing access to and use of the Medius Earth digital MRV and carbon project management platform, including all associated software, dashboards, mobile and WhatsApp-based data capture tools, geospatial and AI analysis modules, reporting tools, and data rooms (collectively, the "Platform").

A.1 Definitions

- **"Platform"** means the Medius Earth technology system described above, including all present and future modules, updates, and associated mobile/web applications.
- **"Authorized User"** means any individual granted a login or access credential to the Platform, whether an internal user (employee, field team member, supervisor, corporate office staff) or an external user (partner project developer, ground operator, funder, auditor/VVB, registry representative, financing or ratings organization, or other approved third party).
- **"Licensee Data"** means all data, content, and information uploaded, submitted, or generated by an Authorized User through the Platform, including field data, images, geolocation data, voice recordings, and project documentation.
- **"Output"** means reports, analyses, dashboards, models, and other materials generated by the Platform, including those generated using artificial intelligence or agentic AI tools.
- **"Related Agreement"** means, collectively, any Scope Document, statement of work, commercial or pricing agreement, order form, or organization-level master agreement entered into separately between Medius Earth and the User's organization, setting out the specific project scope, deliverables, timelines, fees, and other commercial terms applicable to that User's engagement.
- **"Intellectual Property Rights"** means all patents, copyrights, trademarks, trade secrets, database rights, and other proprietary rights, whether registered or unregistered, anywhere in the world.

A.2 Grant of License

A.2.1 Scope of License.

Subject to the User's continued compliance with this License, the Privacy Policy (Part B), and the Terms and Conditions of Use (Part C), Medius Earth grants the User a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sub-licensable, revocable right to access and use the Platform solely for the purpose for which access was granted (e.g., field operations, project monitoring, verification support, due diligence, or registry engagement), and solely for the duration of the User's employment, contractual, or partnership relationship with or through Medius Earth.

A.2.2 Role-Based Access.

Access to specific modules, dashboards, and data sets may be limited according to the User's role (field team, supervisor, corporate office, funder, third-party auditor, carbon registry, service provider, or other category), as configured by Medius Earth from time to time. Medius Earth may modify role-based permissions at its discretion to preserve data integrity and confidentiality.

A.2.3 External Users and Partner Developers.

Where the Platform is made available to an external project developer or ground operator for use alongside their own field teams, this License extends to that organization's Authorized Users, and that organization is responsible for ensuring each of its personnel accepts and complies with this Agreement before receiving access.

A.2.4 Relationship to Scope, Commercial, and Organization-Level Agreements.

Where the User's organization has entered into a separate Scope Document, commercial agreement, order form, or organization-level agreement with Medius Earth (a "Related Agreement"), that Related Agreement governs the business terms of the engagement — including project scope, deliverables, timelines, pricing, payment terms, and service levels. This Platform Access Agreement governs the technology license, intellectual property, data protection and privacy, and platform-use terms of access, and prevails on those subjects even where a Related Agreement also addresses them, unless the Related Agreement expressly states otherwise in writing and is signed by an authorized signatory of Medius Earth. Where a conflict arises on any other matter, this Agreement prevails unless the Related Agreement expressly references and varies a specific clause of this Agreement.

IN PLAIN ENGLISH

You get to log in and use the parts of the platform relevant to your role. You don't own any part of the software — you're being given permission to use it, not a copy of it.

This Agreement is the same for every client and covers the technology and data rules. Your project's scope, timelines, and pricing live in a separate document — if the two ever disagree on a business point like fees or deliverables, that separate document wins; on IP, data, and platform-use rules, this Agreement wins.

A.3 License Restrictions

The User shall not, and shall not permit any third party to:

- copy, modify, adapt, translate, or create derivative works of the Platform or any part of its source code, algorithms, or AI models;
- reverse-engineer, decompile, disassemble, or otherwise attempt to derive the source code or underlying methodology of the Platform;
- sell, resell, rent, lease, sub-license, distribute, or otherwise make the Platform available to any third party not authorized under this Agreement;
- use the Platform to build or assist in building a competing product or service;
- remove, obscure, or alter any proprietary notices, trademarks, or branding on the Platform or its Outputs;
- share login credentials, or allow access by any individual other than the Authorized User to whom credentials were issued;
- use the Platform in violation of applicable law, including data protection, export control, or anti-corruption law.

A.4 Intellectual Property Ownership

A.4.1 Platform IP.

The Platform, including its software, source code, AI models, methodologies, algorithms, user interface, and all related Intellectual Property Rights, is and shall remain the sole and exclusive property of Medius Earth (Hasten Forestry India Pvt. Ltd.). No rights are granted to the User except the limited license expressly set out in Section A.2.

A.4.2 Licensee Data — Ownership and Permitted Use.

Ownership. As between the parties, ownership of Licensee Data remains with the User (or the organization it represents) at all times. Nothing in this Agreement transfers ownership of Licensee Data to Medius Earth.

Operational license. The User grants Medius Earth a worldwide, royalty-free, non-exclusive license to host, process, analyze, reproduce, and use Licensee Data to (i) operate, maintain, and support the Platform for the User, and (ii) generate Outputs for the User and relevant third parties (registries, VVBs, funders) as required for project verification and reporting.

Anonymized and aggregated use. Separately, Medius Earth may use Licensee Data in anonymized, de-identified, and/or aggregated form - from which the User, any individual, or any specific site or project cannot reasonably be re-identified - to train and improve its AI models, benchmark carbon and biodiversity outcomes across projects, and develop and improve the Platform generally. This use is permitted whether or not Medius Earth continues to provide services to the User, and survives termination of this Agreement. **Medius Earth will not disclose to any third party any information relating to the User's site or project - including its location, boundaries, land ownership or tenure details, baseline and monitoring data, methodologies, credit volumes, pricing, or commercial terms - other than information that is already available in the public domain through no act or omission of Medius Earth, except where the User has consented in writing or where disclosure is required by law, regulation, or the order of a court or other competent authority.** Medius Earth will not use Licensee Data in identifiable form for these purposes without the User's separate consent, and this use is subject at all times to the Privacy Policy (Part B) and the DPDP Act.

A.4.3 Outputs.

Outputs generated specifically for a User's project (e.g., that User's carbon sequestration models, PDDs, or monitoring reports) may be used by that User for its own project purposes, including submission to registries and verification bodies. Underlying methodologies, templates, and system-level Outputs remain Medius Earth's property.

A.5 Fees

Where the User's access to the Platform is subject to a fee, revenue share, or milestone-based commercial arrangement, such fees will be set out in the Related Agreement (a separate commercial agreement, order form, or Scope Document) between Medius Earth and the User's organization, per Section A.2.4. This License governs the technology terms of access; it does not itself create a payment obligation unless referenced in such a Related Agreement.

A.6 Term and Termination

A.6.1 Term.

This License takes effect on the date the User accepts this Agreement and continues until terminated as set out below.

A.6.2 Termination for Convenience.

Medius Earth may suspend or terminate a User's access at any time, with or without cause, including where the underlying employment, contractual, or partnership relationship ends.

A.6.3 Termination for Breach.

Medius Earth may immediately suspend or terminate access if the User breaches this License, the Privacy Policy, or the Terms and Conditions of Use, including any unauthorized use, data misuse, or security violation.

A.6.4 Effect of Termination.

Upon termination, the User's right to access the Platform ends immediately. Medius Earth may retain Licensee Data as required for audit, legal, regulatory, or carbon registry purposes even after termination, as further described in Part B.

A.7 Warranties and Disclaimers

Except as expressly stated in this Agreement, the Platform and all Outputs are provided "as is" and "as available," without warranties of any kind, whether express, implied, or statutory, including implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, accuracy, or non-infringement. Medius Earth does not warrant that the Platform will be uninterrupted, error-free, or that Outputs (including AI-generated analysis) will be accurate in every instance; Outputs are decision-support tools and should be reviewed by a qualified person before being relied upon for verification, financing, regulatory, or legal purposes.

A.8 Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, Medius Earth's aggregate liability arising out of or relating to this License shall not exceed the total fees paid by the User's organization to Medius Earth in the twelve (12) months preceding the claim (or, where no fees are payable, shall be limited to direct damages only). In no event shall Medius Earth be liable for indirect, incidental, consequential, special, or punitive damages, including loss of profits, loss of carbon credit revenue, or loss of data, even if advised of the possibility of such damages.

A.9 Indemnification

The User agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Medius Earth, its officers, employees, and affiliates from and against any claims, damages, liabilities, and expenses (including reasonable legal fees) arising from the User's breach of this Agreement, misuse of the Platform, or violation of applicable law.

A.10 Confidentiality

Each party agrees to keep confidential any non-public information disclosed by the other party in connection with the Platform, including project data, commercial terms, and system methodologies, and to use such information solely for the purposes of this Agreement, except where disclosure is required by law or by a carbon registry/verification process for which the information was intended.

A.11 Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

This License is governed by the laws of India. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this License shall first be addressed through good-faith negotiation between the parties for thirty (30) days, failing which it shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration in Bengaluru, Karnataka, in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act,

1996, before a sole arbitrator appointed by mutual agreement. The seat and venue of arbitration shall be Bengaluru, and the language of arbitration shall be English. Nothing in this clause prevents either party from seeking urgent injunctive relief from a court of competent jurisdiction in Bengaluru.

Part B — Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how Medius Earth (Hasten Forestry India Private Limited) collects, uses, stores, shares, and protects personal and project data through the Platform. It applies to all Authorized Users — internal (employees, field teams, supervisors, corporate office) and external (partner developers, ground operators, funders, auditors/VVBs, registries, financing and rating organizations, and other approved third parties).

B.1 Scope and Applicability

This Policy applies to personal data and project data processed through or in connection with the Platform, including data captured in the field (via mobile devices, WhatsApp-based tools, or voice input in local languages), data uploaded to dashboards or the data room, and data generated by the Platform's geospatial and AI analysis modules. This Policy is designed and maintained in compliance with the (Indian) Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023 ("DPDP Act") and, where a User is located outside India, applicable international data protection principles.

B.2 Information We Collect

B.2.1 Account and Identity Data.

Name, role, organization, email address, phone number, login credentials, and authentication records.

B.2.2 Field and Project Data.

Planting and survival counts, species and biodiversity data, geolocation coordinates, site photographs, drone/satellite imagery references, voice recordings and transcriptions (currently supported in multiple Indian languages, with further languages planned), labour and material usage records, and other operational data entered by field teams.

B.2.3 Financial and Commercial Data.

Where relevant to a User's role (e.g., project developers, funders), budget, disbursement, milestone, and carbon credit/revenue data.

B.2.4 Usage and Technical Data.

Device information, IP address, log-in timestamps, access logs, and audit trail records of actions taken on the Platform.

B.2.5 AI-Processed Data.

Outputs generated by the Platform's agentic AI tools when processing multi-modal inputs (text, voice, image) submitted by Authorized Users.

IN PLAIN ENGLISH

We collect what we need to run the platform and prove your project's results: your account details, the data your team enters in the field (including photos, voice notes, and GPS locations), and system logs of who did what and when.

B.3 How We Use Information

- To operate, maintain, and improve the Platform and its features;

- To generate monitoring, verification, and impact reports (including carbon sequestration models, Shannon Diversity Index and biodiversity metrics, and regulatory submissions);
- To support due diligence by funders, project financing organizations, lenders, and rating providers;
- To support engagement with Verification and Validation Bodies (VVBs) and carbon registries (e.g., Verra/VCS, Isometric, India's national carbon registry);
- To maintain audit logs and data integrity records required for carbon credit issuance and verification;
- To communicate with Authorized Users regarding their access, projects, and Platform updates;
- To comply with applicable legal, regulatory, and contractual obligations.

B.4 How We Share Information

We do not sell personal data. We share data only as necessary for the purposes described above, including with:

- Carbon registries and standards bodies, for the purpose of project registration, verification, and credit issuance;
- Third-party auditors and Validation/Verification Bodies (VVBs), for independent verification of project claims;
- Funders, project financing organizations, lenders, and rating providers, where the User's project participates in financing or investment processes;
- Partner project developers and ground operators, where data relates to a shared project;
- Service providers engaged by Medius Earth (e.g., cloud hosting, analytics) under confidentiality and data protection obligations no less protective than this Policy;
- Regulators, courts, or government authorities, where required by law.

B.5 Data Security

The Platform applies encryption to data at rest and in transit, role-based access controls, and comprehensive audit logging of user actions. Access to sensitive data sets is restricted according to the Authorized User's assigned role. While Medius Earth maintains industry-standard security measures, no system can guarantee absolute security, and Users are responsible for safeguarding their own login credentials.

B.6 Data Retention

Personal and project data is retained for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes described in this Policy, including the retention periods required by carbon registries and verification standards (which may extend for the life of a carbon project and its crediting period, often 10-30+ years), and thereafter as required by applicable law. Account data is retained for the duration of the User's access and for a reasonable period thereafter for audit and legal purposes.

B.7 User Rights

Subject to applicable law (including the DPDP Act, 2023, where applicable), Authorized Users may request to:

- access the personal data Medius Earth holds about them;

- correct inaccurate or incomplete personal data;
 - request deletion of personal data, subject to Medius Earth's legitimate need to retain records for audit, verification, legal, or contractual purposes (in particular, field and project data forming part of a carbon project's audit trail generally cannot be deleted while the project remains active or under registry review);
 - withdraw consent for optional processing, where consent is the basis for that processing;
 - raise a grievance with Medius Earth's designated contact point (Section B.11).

B.8 Cross-Border Data Transfer

Where Medius Earth engages cloud infrastructure or service providers located outside India, or shares data with international registries, funders, or verification bodies, such transfers will be made under appropriate contractual safeguards and in compliance with applicable data transfer requirements.

B.9 Children's Privacy

The Platform is intended for use by adult professionals in connection with their employment, contractual, or partnership role. It is not directed at, and Medius Earth does not knowingly collect personal data from, individuals under the age of 18.

B.10 Changes to this Policy

Medius Earth may update this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect changes in the Platform, legal requirements, or business practices. Material changes will be notified to Authorized Users through the Platform or by email, and continued use of the Platform after such notice constitutes acceptance of the updated Policy.

Part C — Terms and Conditions of Use

These Terms and Conditions of Use ("Terms") govern day-to-day use of the Platform by all Authorized Users, in addition to the License Agreement (Part A) and Privacy Policy (Part B). By accessing the Platform, you agree to these Terms.

C.1 Acceptance of Terms

Access to the Platform is conditional on acceptance of these Terms, the License Agreement, and the Privacy Policy in full. If you are accepting on behalf of an organization, you confirm that you have the authority to bind that organization, and "you"/"User" in these Terms refers to both you individually and the organization you represent.

C.2 Eligibility and Account Registration

Access is provided only to individuals authorized by Medius Earth or by an approved partner organization. Each Authorized User must register using accurate, current information and is responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of their login credentials and for all activity occurring under their account.

C.3 User Roles and Access Levels

The Platform supports multiple categories of Authorized Users, each with access calibrated to their function, including but not limited to:

- Field teams and supervisors — data capture, daily operations tracking;
- Corporate office personnel — project oversight, reporting, and analytics;
- Partner project developers and ground operators — end-to-end project management;
- Funders, project financing organizations, lenders, and rating providers — due diligence and data room access;
- Third-party auditors and Validation/Verification Bodies (VVBs) — verification review access;
- Carbon registries — registry-specific reporting and issuance tracking access.

Medius Earth reserves the right to determine, configure, and modify the scope of access appropriate to each role.

C.4 Acceptable Use

Authorized Users agree to:

- provide accurate, complete, and current data at all times, recognizing that carbon and ESG claims depend on data integrity;
- use the Platform only for legitimate project, verification, financing, or oversight purposes connected to their role;
- promptly report any suspected security vulnerability, unauthorized access, or data inaccuracy to Medius Earth;
- comply with all applicable laws, including data protection, environmental, and anti-corruption laws.

Authorized Users agree not to:

- upload false, misleading, unlawful, or infringing content;
- attempt to gain unauthorized access to any part of the Platform, other users' accounts, or underlying infrastructure;
- interfere with or disrupt the Platform's security, integrity, or performance (including introducing malware or attempting denial-of-service activity);
- use the Platform to harass, defame, or infringe the rights of any person or entity.

C.5 AI and Multi-Modal Features

The Platform uses agentic AI to process multi-modal inputs — including text, voice (across multiple local languages), and images — and to assist with report generation, data visualization, and analysis. Authorized Users acknowledge that:

- AI-generated Outputs are decision-support tools intended to accelerate and assist human review, not to replace professional judgment;
- Outputs used for regulatory submission, carbon verification, financing decisions, or other consequential purposes should be reviewed and validated by a qualified person before reliance;
- Medius Earth continuously works to improve translation, transcription, and analytical accuracy, but does not warrant that AI Outputs will be error-free.

IN PLAIN ENGLISH

The AI on the platform is a very capable assistant, not the final word — always have a qualified person sanity-check anything AI-generated before it goes into a report, filing, or funding decision.

C.6 Data Accuracy and User Responsibility

Each Authorized User is responsible for the accuracy of data they personally enter or upload. Medius Earth is not responsible for losses arising from inaccurate, incomplete, or fraudulent data entered by a User, though Medius Earth's audit-logging and data integrity features are designed to help identify and flag such issues.

C.7 Third-Party Integrations

The Platform may interoperate with third-party systems (e.g., registry portals, satellite/geospatial data providers, financial systems). Medius Earth is not responsible for the availability, accuracy, or practices of third-party systems, which are governed by their own terms.

C.8 Suspension and Termination of Access
